

Breeding Contract

This agreement is made by and between (name) _____ residing at (address) _____

Hereinafter referred to as "mare owner" and Les Bateman and Paul Peterson, located at Rt 1 Box 8, Devol, OK 73531, hereinafter referred to as "stallion owners".

Stallion owners are owners of Im Genuine Gold a 1999 AQHA/PHBA palomino stallion. Mare owner owns (name of mare) _____ foaled in _____ (year) Reg No. _____ out of (sire's name) _____ Due to foal or n/a if open _____.

Im Genuine Gold is standing at stud for the 2009 season at Peterson Quarter Horses and the parties hereto wish to contract with mare owner for one season's booking to Im Genuine Gold.

This service is subject to the following conditions:

Fees

Stallion breeding fee is \$700.00 (\$500.00 to the first 10 mares booked) which includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$100.00, which is payable upon execution of this contract. The balance of the breeding fee \$600.00 (or \$400.00) plus all unpaid board and expenses will be paid when mare is picked up.

Board and veterinary care

In addition to breeding fees, mare owner agrees to pay a price to be negotiated with Peterson Quarter Horses for the following care:

Wet inside care feed and board	\$12.00
Dry inside care feed and board	\$10.00
Wet/dry outside care	\$7.00

Peterson Quarter Horses agrees to use reasonable care and caution for mare and/or foal while in their possession or control, pursuant to this agreement, and are authorized to obtain any necessary veterinarian or farrier care as required, but only after taking reasonable steps to contact mare owner without success. Mare owner is to provide local veterinarian of his/her choice and nearest veterinarian hospital with assurance of full payment for any and all treatment so made.

Health/other requirements

All mares are to be immunized for Rhinopneumanitis and West Nile Virus. Mares not so immunized will be vaccinated shortly after arrival at mare owner's expense.

A negative Coggins Test for equine infectious anemia (Swamp Fever) is required prior to the mare's arrival at Peterson Quarter Horses.

Mare owner agrees to allow Peterson Quarter Horses to have a qualified veterinarian check the mare for normal breeding conditions, and to perform other vet services that stallion owners may deem necessary for proper treatment and

protection of the mare and/or foal at her side. Mare owner is responsible for paying for said services before mare is picked up from breeding farm.

Liability

Mare owner agrees to assume the risk of injury, sickness, or death to said mare and/or foal at her side except when caused by negligence of Peterson Quarter Horses, its agents, officers, contractors or employees.

Rebreeding

Stallion owners guarantee a return breeding the following season provided the stallion is able to service mares, either for said mare or an approved substitute should a live foal not result from this mating. For the purpose of this agreement, a live foal shall be one that stands and nurses without assistance. This is to be evidenced by a written statement from a qualified veterinarian.

If prior breeding of said mare or after mare has been bred but not come in foal, said stallion or mare dies or becomes unfit for service as declared by a licensed veterinarian, then this agreement shall become null and void and all monies paid by mare owner, EXCEPT expenses and booking fee, shall be refunded.

Indemnification

Mare owner agrees to indemnify and hold stallion owners and Peterson Quarter Horses harmless for any loss or injury due to acts of said mare and/or foal at her side while on the premises or under control of stallion owners or Peterson Quarter Horses, their officers, agents, contractors, or employees.

Breeder's Certificate

A breeder's certificate will be issued upon request of mare owner at any time after the mare has foaled and all charges have been paid in full.

Governing law

This agreement is governed by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma. Any legal action must be brought in Cotton County.

Arbitration

The parties to this agreement mutually agree that any and all disputes arising in connection with this agreement will be settled and determined by binding arbitration in accordance with the then existing rules of the American Arbitration Association by one or more arbitrators in accordance with said rules. Said arbitration shall take place in Walters, Oklahoma.

Entire Agreement

This constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. Any modifications and/or additions MUST be in writing and signed by all parties to this agreement. No oral modifications or additions will be considered to be part of this agreement unless reduced to writing and signed by all parties.
